Analysis of feedback from Alumni, Students and Teachers of the College for the
Academic Year 2021-2022, M.B. College, Imphal

Feedbacks were collected from alumni, students and teachers which were analyzed by IQAC. The numbers of feedback were reduced due to Covid 19 pandemic for academic session 2021-2022. The separate questionnaires were prepared for alumni, students and teachers. The questionnaire had various aspects of the college specially on learning experience, syllabus, learning environment, departments and faculties, library facilities. 5 alumni responded to the feedbacks. The suggestions from the alumni include change in the curriculum and syllabus, improvement in teaching-learning process and use of more ICT facilities. The alumni also suggested for introduction of home science, vocational and skill related courses. 7 students of the College responded to the feedbacks. The suggestions from the students include change in the syllabus; introduction of sports related courses and need for learning on Manipuri culture and use of smart classes. The students desired that College in future produce more academicians and other professionals.

11 teachers of the College responded to the feedback. The questionnaire for the teachers contained questions on syllabus, programmes, prescribed books, facilities in the College, freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching, testing and assessment of students, teaching environment, research and project facilities, relationship between administration and teachers. The collected feedbacks and suggestions were analyzed and discussed by IQAC, Principal and Academic Committee of the College. Corrective measures were taken accordingly. After the adoption of National Education Policy 2020 in the coming years, some of these suggestions will be fully implemented.
