Analysis of feedback from Alumni, Students and Teachers of the College for the Academic Year 2020-2021 of M.B. College, Imphal

Separate questionnaires were prepared for alumni, students and teachers for collecting and analyzing feedback. Due to Covid 19 pandemic and lockdowns during the academic session 2020-2021, the numbers of feedback were reduced. The questionnaires were on the various aspects of the college specially on learning experience, syllabus, learning environment, departments and faculties, library facilities. 6 alumni responded to the feedbacks. The suggestions from the alumni include change in the curriculum and syllabus, improvement in teaching-learning process, use of more ICT facilities and need for introduction of home science, vocational and skill related courses. 6 students of the College responded to the feedbacks. The suggestions from the students include change in the syllabus, introduction of sports related courses and wished that College to produce more academicians and other professionals, need for learning on Manipuri culture and use of smart classes. 15 teachers of the College responded to the feedback. The questionnaire for the teachers contained questions on syllabus, programmes, prescribed books, facilities in the College, freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching, testing and assessment of students, teaching environment, research and project facilities, relationship between administration and teachers.

The collected feedbacks and suggestions were analyzed and discussed by IQAC, Principal and Academic Committee of the College. Corrective measures were taken up for the interest of the students and the College. The teachers were requested to take up measures to improve the curriculum delivery and improvements in teaching-learning. It is hoped that some of suggestions will be implemented with the likely adoption of National Education Policy 2020 in the coming years.
